

Curriculum Vitae: Univ.-Prof. Dr. med. Sarah König, MME

Sarah König is a Full Professor of Medical Education and Director of the Institute for Medical Education and Educational Research at the University Hospital Würzburg. She has been the Dean of Studies at the Faculty of Medicine since 2019.

She studied medicine in Göttingen and was awarded her doctorate in 1999. From 1999 to 2016, she undertook clinical training in various surgical departments at the University Medical Centre Göttingen, including general and visceral surgery, paediatric surgery, trauma surgery, and reconstructive surgery. She completed her habilitation in Surgery in 2009 and holds board certifications in general surgery (2007) and visceral surgery (2015), as well as a Master of Medical Education (Heidelberg, 2014).

In her current role as Chair of Medical Education and Dean of Studies, Professor König has played a leading role in the development and implementation of Würzburg's structured, three-step medical didactics qualification programme, in collaboration with the Bavarian Competence Network for Medical Education. She is an active trainer in faculty development and regularly teaches at academic medical centres across Germany.

She is a member of the Presidential Commission for Quality Assurance at the University of Würzburg and serves as a reviewer for degree programmes in subject-specific accreditation procedures. In addition, she is deeply involved in academic governance, chairs key curricular committees, and acts as an expert for national medical licensing examinations.

Her research focuses on competency-based education and assessment, interprofessional teamwork, digital learning formats, and evaluation in medical training.
