

Prof. Dr. Annette Lebeau, MD, PhD, is a consultant and senior lecturer in pathology at the University Medical Centre Hamburg-Eppendorf in Hamburg, Germany, since 2006. She is also partner in the private group practice for pathology in Lübeck, Germany, since 2006. In 2004, she earned her Postdoctoral Qualification (Habilitation, PhD) at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University in Munich, Germany, where she also completed her residency in anatomical pathology in 1997. Dr Lebeau obtained her Doctor of Medicine in 1991 and her Medical Degree in 1988 at the Medical University of Lübeck, Germany.

She has particular expertise in the field of breast pathology including biomarker diagnostics and is the author of numerous publications in this field.

Selected voluntary activities: She is a member of the Steering Group and chair of the Pathology Working Group of the German interdisciplinary S3 guidelines for the early detection, diagnosis, treatment and follow-up care of breast cancer. In 2015, she was appointed to the Guideline Development Group (GDG) of the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer (ECIBC). She is member of the Scientific Advisory Council of the German Mammography Screening Program since 2009, where she also serves as appointed reference pathologist. She is a Board Member of the German Society of Senology (DGS) as well as Vice-President of the Professional Association of German Pathologists (BDP) since 2019.
